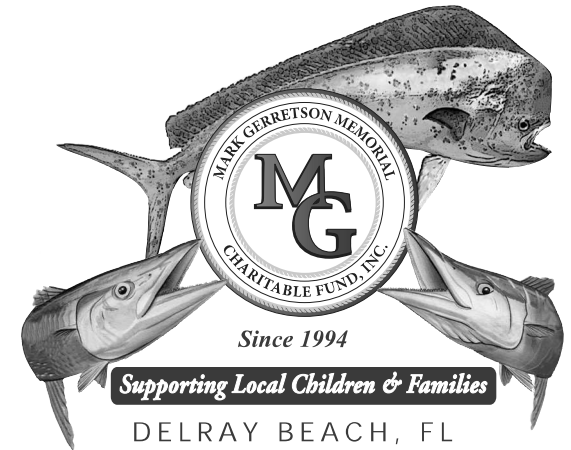

Mark Gerretson Memorial Fishing Tournament.



Mark Gerretson founded this fishing tournament in 1994 at first to support the Delray Beach Police Department's Holiday Toy Drive. Over the years, the tournament has cast a wider net and the funds generated have been used to support local charities focusing on underprivileged children and have also been used for college scholarships for local high school graduates. Last year's tournament raised approximately \$15,500 that has been donated to charities and students.

Mark, a native of Delray Beach, was a true outdoorsman and avid fisherman. He devoted an extraordinary amount of time to the local community through the Delray Beach Jaycees, the Delray Affair, the Elks Club and his fishing tournament. Mark passed away in 2005 and his family and friends have kept his memory alive by continuing the tournament and naming it the Mark Gerretson Memorial Fishing Tournament. Mark was survived by his mother, Patricia Gerretson, siblings James Gerretson and Deena Chapman (1958-2019), his uncle and aunt, Jerry and Barbara Kern, and a truckload of cousins, nieces and nephews. Several friends, Jennifer Buce and Tim Knapp, have worked tirelessly throughout the years to make the tournament a continued success.
